Please see below some ideas of how you can celebrate Recreation Professionals Week while social distancing!

1. Proclamation at your municipality's council meeting (if meetings are still taking place)
2. Hang posters on outdoor bulletin boards; highlight your community's recreation professional(s)
3. Put an ad in your local newspaper or newsletter
4. Purchase a radio ad; share fun stories about your local recreation professional(s) and thank them for all they do for your community
5. Share a virtual meal or coffee time with fellow recreation professionals
6. Set up 'thank you' posters and balloons on their front lawn
7. Recognize your local recreation professional(s) on social media and website by creating a fun video, saying "THANK YOU" – letting them know they are appreciated
8. Contact your local user groups: ask them to send virtual messages to their local recreation professional(s)
9. Have a parade: ask Town/City staff and councillors to each drive a vehicle that is decorated in honor of their recreational professional(s). In small communities, you can include all essential services. Make it a HUGE DEAL!
